| 1 | First Sunday of Lent | Genesis 2:15-17; 3:1-7 Psalm 32 Romans 5:12-19 Matthew 4:1-11 | Lent comes from the Latin word for "fortieth". These forty days are set aside to prepare the Church for easter; recalling the death and resurrection of our Lord. |
| 8 | Second Sunday of Lent | Genesis 12:1-4a Psalm 121 Romans 4:1-5, 13-17 John 3:1-17 or Matthew 17:1-9 | |

| 14 | Proper | Genesis 18:1-15, (21:1-7) and Psalm 116:1-2, 12-19 Exodus 19:2-8a and Psalm 100 Romans 5:1-8 Matthew 9:35-10:8, (9-23) | Proper or Ordinary time is the portion of the Church calendar which sits outside of the high festivals. It comprises the majority of the year and is the season where the Church deepens its love for God and grows in maturity. Consider it "meat and potatoes" faith. |
